



## COVID-19 Policies & Procedures

**The following is the list of policies and procedures currently in place to protect against transmission and spread of the novel coronavirus at Adora Childcare. These procedures adhere to guidelines published by the Centers for Disease Control, American Academy of Pediatrics, SCDHEC and DSS:**

- Reduced morning hours – not enough families needing early morning care
- Increased frequency of sanitizing and hand washing procedures.
- Limit group sizing and combining of classroom and age groups.
- All staff to undergo health screenings at the facility upon arrival. Staff will document and notify management immediately if showing signs of a fever or other symptoms.
- Staff members are required to wear face masks while at work.
- Parents are required to conduct health screenings for all household members before arrival. This includes checking for symptoms and taking temperature. If anything is present, children should not attend for the day or until symptoms alleviate.
- Adora CC management will document and monitor any child who becomes ill while under our care. Distancing guidelines will be used, and children will be moved to a separate part of the center until parent arrives for pick-up.
- Should a positive case occur, center will immediately inform SC DHEC and DSS and follow advised protocol and procedures.
